The positions we currently have available are:

Registrar:

- Handles athlete registrations
- Maintains membership records
- Ensures compliance with league requirements

Uniform/Merchandise Coordinator:

- Distributes and orders clothing for the club

Coaches:

- Train & mentor athletes in various events
- Provide guidance on technique and performance improvement

Parent Assistant Coaches:

- Support the head coaches and work directly with athletes during training sessions and competitions

Team Managers:

- Help select and register athletes and notify parents of opportunities to compete in regional and state events

Chief Official:

- Officiate events during competitions
- Ensure rules are followed
- Accurately record results and check records

On Track Coordinator:

- Run the computer with athlete results
- Notify athletes and parents of new PB's

Volunteer Coordinator:

- Recruit & organise volunteers for various club activities and events

Event Coordinator:

- Plan & oversee club events, including competitions, social gatherings and fundraisers

Equipment Manager:

- Manage the inventory of athletic equipment
- Ensure equipment is maintained
- Coordinate equipment purchases where necessary

Timing Gate Coordinator / Starting Marshall:

- Help to setup timing gates
- Ensure efficient running of track events

Communications Officer:

- Handle club communications including newsletters, handbook, social media and website content.

Child Safety Officer:

- Ensure the safety of athletes during training and competitions
- Implement safety protocols

Parent Liaison / Welcoming Officer:

- Serves as a point of contact for parents
- Addresses concerns
- Facilitates communication between parents and club management
- Assists with conflict resolution

Fundraising Coordinator:

- Organises fundraising activities to support the financial needs and goals of the club

Photographer:

- Works with communication officer.

Canteen / BBQ Coordinators:

- Organises food and drinks for club nights (must have food handler certificate)
- Run the BBQ (preference to have food handler certificate)

Awards & Trophies Coordinator:

- Order trophies as required
- Ensure engraving is completed
